The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act regulating the Approval of Accounts at Massachusetts State College.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section five of chapter seventy-five of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out said section
3 five and inserting in place thereof the following:—
4 *Section 5.* All accounts for maintenance and for
5 expenditures under special appropriations shall be
6 approved by the trustees or, if the trustees shall so
7 vote, by the vice president or some other officer of the
8 board of trustees or another trustee appointive or
9 ex-officio designated by the vice president, and shall
10 be filed with the comptroller, and shall be paid by the
11 commonwealth. Full copies of the payrolls and bills
12 shall be kept at the college.
