The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act authorizing the Boston Elevated Railway Company to sell its Surplus Power to the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Boston Elevated Railway Company is hereby
2 authorized to sell, and the city of Boston is hereby
3 authorized to buy, the surplus power, if any, of said
4 company, and said city is hereby authorized to use
5 power so purchased for such municipal purposes as
6 it may deem advisable.
