Resolve providing for an Investigation by the Metropolitan District Commission relative to the Advisability of acquiring Certain Real Estate on Endicott Avenue in the City of Revere for Reservation Purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That the metropolitan district commis-
2 sion is hereby authorized and directed to investigate
3 the advisability and probable cost of the acquisi-
4 tion, by purchase or otherwise, by said commission,
5 for reservation purposes of all the real estate, not
6 already owned by the commonwealth, abutting on
7 the easterly side of Endicott avenue in the city of
8 Revere between the junction of Winthrop avenue,
9 Winthrop parkway and said Endicott avenue and a
10 point on said easterly side of Endicott avenue eight
11 hundred feet northerly of said junction.

12 Said commission shall report to the general court
13 the results of its investigation and its recommenda-
14 tions, if any, together with drafts of legislation neces-
15 sary to carry said recommendations into effect, by
16 filing the same with the clerk of the house of repre-
17 sentatives on or before the first Wednesday of De-
18 cember in the current year.
