*Ordered*, That the powers of the special commission established to investigate certain matters relating to the district court system of the Commonwealth, the trial of civil actions in district courts by juries of six, the extension of the rule-making power of the Supreme Judicial Court and increasing the number of justices of the Superior Court (see chapter 62 of the resolves of the current year) be enlarged to include the subject matter of the bill relative to the administrative committee of district courts and relative to the time of opening court in all such courts, being Senate Document No. 501 of the current year.
