The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act relative to the Terms of Certain Bonds, Notes or other Forms of Written Acknowledgment of Debt to be issued by the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The term of the bonds which the state
2 treasurer is authorized to issue under chapter four
3 hundred and fifteen of the acts of the current year,
4 providing for the acquisition by the commonwealth
5 of additional property for the Salisbury Beach reser-
6 vation and relative to the maintenance of said reser-
7 vation, shall not exceed ten years, as recommended
8 by the governor in a message to the general court
9 dated August fourteenth, nineteen hundred and thirty-
10 five, in pursuance of section three of Article LXII of
11 the amendments to the constitution.

1 SECTION 2. The term of the notes which the state
2 treasurer is authorized to issue under chapter four
3 hundred and seventy-four of the acts of the current
4 year, providing for additional court house accommo-
5 dations and facilities for the courts and other officials
6 in the county of Suffolk by the use of federal, state
7 and city of Boston funds, shall not exceed ten years,
8 as recommended by the governor in a message to the

9 general court dated August fourteenth, nineteen hun-
10 dred and thirty-five, in pursuance of section three of
11 Article LXII of the amendments to the constitution.

1 SECTION 3. The term of the bonds, notes and other
2 forms of written acknowledgment of debt which the
3 state treasurer is authorized to issue under chapter
4 four hundred and seventy-eight of the acts of the
5 current year, providing for the construction of addi-
6 tional sewers in the north metropolitan sewerage dis-
7 trict, shall not exceed twenty years, as recommended
8 by the governor in a message to the general court
9 dated August fourteenth, nineteen hundred and
10 thirty-five, in pursuance of section three of Article
11 LXII of the amendments to the constitution.
