In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Eight.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF A DEPUTY IN THE DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE AUDITOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section five of chapter eleven of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby
3 amended by striking out, in the second and third lines,
4 the words "not exceeding thirty-five hundred dol-
5 lars" and inserting in place thereof the words:— to
6 be fixed by the auditor with the approval of the
7 governor and council, — so as to read as follows:—
8 *Section 5.* He may, subject to confirmation by the
9 governor and council, appoint a deputy in his depart-
10 ment at a salary to be fixed by the auditor with the
11 approval of the governor and council. The require-
12 ments of section two as to the bonding of the first
13 deputy shall apply to the deputy appointed here-
14 under.
