AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME FOR THE TAKING EFFECT OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TUNNELS OR SUBWAYS IN THE CITY OF BOSTON AND THE PURCHASE AND REMOVAL OF CERTAIN ELEVATED STRUCTURES IN SAID CITY, WITH THE AID OF FEDERAL FUNDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section thirteen of chapter four hundred and ninety-
2 two of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-five is
3 hereby amended by striking out said section thirteen
4 and inserting in place thereof the following new
5 section:—

6 *Section 13.* The remaining provisions of this act
7 shall take effect upon their acceptance by vote of the
8 city council of the city, approved by the mayor, and
9 by the Boston Elevated Railway Company, by vote

10 of its stockholders and by vote of its board of directors,
11 and upon the filing of certificates of such acceptance
12 with the secretary of the commonwealth, provided
13 that such acceptances, approval and filing occur
14 during the current year.
