AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE OPERATION OF RAILROADS
WITHIN TWENTY MILES OF BOSTON BY ELECTRICITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter one hundred and sixty of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by inserting after section one
3 hundred and fifty-three, as appearing in the Ter-
4 centenary Edition, the following new section:—
5 *Section 153A.* Notwithstanding the provisions of
6 section one hundred and fifty-three, every railroad
7 corporation having a terminus in Boston shall, on
8 and after January first, nineteen hundred and forty,
9 operate that part of its railroad within twenty miles
10 of said Boston by electricity and not by any other
11 power.
