AN ACT PLACING THE OFFICES OF MOTOR TRUCK DRIVERS,
MOTOR TRUCK OPERATORS AND CHAUFFEURS OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL DISEASES UNDER THE CIVIL
SERVICE LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The offices of motor truck drivers, motor truck
2 operators and chauffeurs of the department of mental
3 diseases shall upon the passage of this act, become
4 subject to the civil service laws and rules and regu-
5 lations relating to the permanent members of said
6 occupations in the employ of the commonwealth of
7 Massachusetts, and the tenure of office or employ-
8 ment of any incumbent thereof shall be unlimited,
9 subject, however, to such laws and rules and regu-
10 lations; but the persons holding said offices on said
11 effective date may continue to serve as such with-
12 out taking a civil service examination.
