AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF FISH WAYS
ON THE JONES RIVER IN THE COUNTY OF PLYMOUTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For the purpose of construction of fish ways on
2 the Jones river and its tributaries in the county of
3 Plymouth, the supervisor of the bureau of marine
4 fisheries of the department of conservation may
5 expend such sum not to exceed thirty-five hundred
6 dollars as may be appropriated by the general court.
7 Such fish ways shall be constructed at such points on
8 the said river and its tributaries as the said supervisor
9 may after hearing determine. The supervisor in
10 carrying out the provisions of this act shall act under
11 procedure set forth in section twenty-three C, chapter
12 one hundred and twenty-nine A, as inserted by chap-
13 ter three hundred and twenty-nine of the acts of
14 nineteen hundred and thirty-three.
