The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Eight.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF MEMBERS OF CONTRIBUTORY SYSTEMS IN CERTAIN COUNTIES AFTER THIRTY YEARS OF SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (1) of section twenty-three of chapter
2 thirty-two of the General Laws, as appearing in sec-
3 tion one of chapter four hundred of the acts of nine-
4 teen hundred and thirty-six, is hereby amended by
5 inserting after the word "sixty" in the second line
6 the words: — , or any member who has had at least
7 thirty years of service, — so that the first sentence
8 of said paragraph will read as follows:— Any mem-
9 ber in service who shall have attained age sixty,
10 or any member who has had at least thirty years of
11 service, upon his own written application to the
12 board shall, or upon that of the head of his depart-
13 ment or, in the case of heads of departments, upon
14 that of the county commissioners, acting as such or as
15 trustees of the hospital district, may, be retired for
16 superannuation not less than thirty nor more than
17 ninety days after the filing of such application.
