AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE  
TO OFFER PRIZES FOR AND TO CONDUCT EXHIBITS OF  
DAIRY GOATS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (f) of section two of chapter one hundred  
2 and twenty-eight of the General Laws, as amended by  
3 section one of chapter four hundred and fifteen of the  
4 acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-seven, is hereby  
5 further amended by inserting after the word "hares"  
6 in the fourth line the words:— dairy goats,— so as  
7 to read as follows:— (f) Offer prizes for and conduct  
8 exhibits of flowers, fruit, vegetables, grasses, grains  
9 or other farm crops, dairy products, honey, horses,  
10 cattle, sheep, swine, poultry, poultry products, rab-  
11 bits, hares, dairy goats, farm operations, and canned  
12 and dried fruits and vegetables, and offer prizes for,  
13 and in aid of, the elimination and suppression of insect  
14 pests.
