AN ACT TO PRESERVE RIGHTS WHICH AROSE UNDER CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE LAW OF THE ROAD PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF CHAPTER FORTY-NINE OF THE ACTS OF NINETEEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY-SIX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter forty-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred
2 and thirty-six is hereby amended by adding at the
3 end the following new section:—

4 *Section 2.* The provisions of this act shall in no
5 way affect any cause of action which accrued prior
6 to February thirteenth, nineteen hundred and thirty-
7 six.
