AN ACT TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS
TO DEEPEN AND IMPROVE THE CHANNEL OF THE IPSWICH
RIVER, IN THE TOWN OF IPSWICH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is
2 hereby directed to deepen and improve the channel
3 of the Ipswich river in the town of Ipswich, and for
4 that purpose may expend a sum not exceeding twenty
5 thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on its passage.
