AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT BY THE CITY OF MEDFORD OF COUNSEL FEES AND EXPENSES OF COUNSEL FOR RESTORING THE MEMBERS OF THE LICENSING BOARD OF THE CITY OF MEDFORD TO THEIR OFFICES AND RESTRAINING OTHERS FROM USURPING THEIR POWERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The city of Medford is hereby authorized and
2 empowered to pay counsel fees and expenses of
3 counsel arising out of legal action undertaken to
4 restore and which did result in restoration of the
5 members of the licensing board of the said city of
6 Medford to their respective offices after removal by
7 the mayor of the city of Medford in nineteen hundred
8 and thirty-four, and, further, to pay counsel fees and
9 expenses of counsel arising out of legal action under-
10 taken to restrain and which did result in restraining
11 the board of aldermen in the said city of Medford
12 from usurping the powers of the said licensing board.
