AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF PLYMOUTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter thirty-four of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section five, as appearing in
3 the Tercentenary Edition, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following:—

5 Section 5. The salaries of county commissioners,
6 payable by their respective counties in full for all
7 services performed by said commissioners except as
8 otherwise provided, shall be as follows:—

11	Berkshire	2,100
12	Norfolk, Hampden, Bristol, Plymouth	3,000
