### AN ACT MAKING MANUFACTURERS AND PRODUCERS LIABLE TO RETAIL BUYERS OF THEIR GOODS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter one hundred and six is hereby amended by  
2 inserting the following section, to be known as section  
3 seventeen A, after section seventeen:—

4 Where goods are sold to a retail purchaser, regard-  
5 less of the provisions of section seventeen of this  
6 chapter, unless there is a stipulation to the contrary or  
7 unless there is an agreement to the contrary between  
8 the buyer and seller, an implied warranty of fitness shall  
9 extend from the manufacturer or producer thereof to  
10 the retail purchaser.
