In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Eight.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF MARRIED WOMEN IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No married woman whose husband
2 is employed by the commonwealth or by any county,
3 city or town shall be eligible for employment in the
4 service thereof while her husband is in the employ of
5 said commonwealth or of such county, city or town.

1 SECTION 2. Whoever is guilty of the violation of
2 section one of this act shall be punished by a fine of
3 not more than one hundred dollars.
