By Mr. Andrews of Clinton, petition of Charles W. McDermott and another (selectmen) that the town of Clinton be authorized to pension the widow of George O'Toole who was killed in performance of duty as an employee of said town. Pensions.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF CLINTON TO PENSION CATHERINE O'TOOLE, THE WIDOW OF GEORGE O'TOOLE, WHO WAS KILLED WHILE IN THE SERVICE OF SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For the purpose of discharging its moral obligation
2 in the premises and for the purpose of promoting the
3 public good, the town of Clinton may pension, in an
4 amount not to exceed one thousand dollars per year,
5 Catherine O'Toole of said Clinton, because of the
6 death of her husband, George O'Toole, who was
7 killed while in the performance of his duties as an
8 employee of said town; said pension to continue
9 during the lifetime of said Catherine O'Toole unless
10 she sooner remarries.
