AN ACT FURTHER EXTENDING THE JURISDICTION OF THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one of chapter one hundred and fifty-nine
2 B of the General Laws, as amended by chapter two
3 hundred and sixty-four of the acts of nineteen hun-
4 dred and thirty-four, is hereby further amended by
5 inserting after the word "applicant" in the twenty-
6 second line of the second paragraph thereof the fol-
7 lowing: — if and so long as he is an "insured person"
8 under chapter one hundred and fifty-two of the Gen-
9 eral Laws (Tercentenary Edition), as amended.
