

HOUSE No. 1396

By Mr. Troy of Boston, petition of John E. Troy, Jr., that the Metropolitan District Commission be authorized to construct a roadway for commercial traffic bordering on Old Colony Parkway in the Dorchester district of Boston. Metropolitan Affairs.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION OF A ROADWAY FOR COMMERCIAL TRAFFIC BORDERING THE OLD COLONY PARKWAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commis-
2 sion, hereinafter called the commission, is hereby
3 authorized and directed to lay out and construct a
4 roadway for commercial traffic on the easterly side
5 of Old Colony parkway from a point at or near Old
6 Colony terrace to a point at or near Mount Vernon
7 street.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of acquiring the land
2 required for said roadway not now owned by the
3 commonwealth and for the laying out and construction
4 of said roadway, the commission may expend such

5 sum, not exceeding thirty-five thousand dollars, as
6 may hereafter be appropriated. The total expendi-
7 ture made under authority of this section shall be
8 paid from the Highway Fund for the current year.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
