AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF ANNUITIES TO DEPENDENTS OF FOREMEN, SUBFOREMEN, INSPECTORS, CHAUFFEURS, MECHANICS AND LABORERS OF CITIES AND TOWNS KILLED OR DYING FROM INJURIES RECEIVED OR HAZARDS UNDERGONE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF DUTIES AS SUCH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter thirty-two of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section eighty-nine, as
3 most recently amended by chapter three hundred
4 and twenty-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and
5 thirty-six, the following new section:—
6 *Section 89A.* The provisions of the preceding sec-
7 tion shall apply to foremen, subforemen, inspectors,
8 chauffeurs, mechanics and laborers of a city or town
9 in the same manner as in the case of a member of the
10 police or fire force of such city or town, except that

11 the provisions of said section shall apply only to the
12 deaths of such foremen, subforemen, inspectors,
13 chauffeurs, mechanics and laborers resulting from
14 injuries received from hazards undergone or occur-
15 ring on or after January first, nineteen hundred and
16 thirty-eight.
