AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TRANSPORTATION OF PASSENGERS FOR HIRE BY MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter one hundred and fifty-nine A of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section
3 eight, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, the
4 following new section: —

5 *Section 8A.* No motor vehicle operated under any
6 license issued under the provisions of this chapter
7 shall carry passengers in excess of the seating capacity
8 of such vehicle; provided, that passengers not in
9 excess of twenty per cent of such seating capacity
10 may be carried not more than eight miles.
