## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR SUBMISSION TO THE VOTERS OF REVERE OF PLAN A AND PLAN B AT THE STATE ELECTION IN THE CURRENT YEAR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. On the ballot at the state election in  
2 the city of Revere in the current year there shall be  
3 placed the two following questions:—

4 1. Shall the city of Revere adopt the form of govern-  
5 ment defined as Plan A, consisting of  
6 government by a mayor and nine coun-  
7 cillors elected at large?

8 2. Shall the city of Revere adopt the form of gov-  
9 ernment defined as Plan B, consisting of  
10 government by a mayor and by coun-  
11 cillors elected partly at large and partly  
12 from wards or districts?

## INSTRUCTION TO VOTERS.

16 Vote for only one of the following plans. A vote  
17 in favor of both does not count for either.

1 SECTION 2. If a majority of the voters voting for  
2 governor at said election vote in favor of one or the  
3 other of said plans, the plan receiving the higher vote  
4 of the two shall be deemed to have been adopted, if  
5 it has received a majority of the votes cast for and  
6 against said plan; otherwise both plans shall be  
7 deemed to have failed of adoption.

1 SECTION 3. If either of said plans is adopted,  
2 chapter forty-three of the General Laws shall apply  
3 to the city of Revere to the extent provided by section  
4 eleven thereof.
