AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF INSURANCE
BROKERS' LICENSES WITHOUT FEE TO CERTAIN PERSONS
SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one hundred and sixty-seven A of chapter
2 one hundred and seventy-five of the General Laws, as
3 most recently amended by chapter two hundred and
4 sixty of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-seven,
5 is hereby further amended by adding at the end the
6 following:—, or of or on account of any person
7 sixty-five years of age or over who has been the holder
8 of such a license during the whole or any part of each
9 of the ten years immediately preceding the date of
10 application for a renewal of such license.
