By Mr. Hedges of Quincy, petition of Charles W. Hedges that fire districts, wards in cities and precincts in towns be authorized to establish zoning regulations within their own limits. Mercantile Affairs.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT FIRE DISTRICTS, WARDS IN CITIES AND PRECINCTS IN TOWNS MAY ESTABLISH ZONING WITHIN THEIR OWN LIMITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Fire districts by by-law and wards of cities and
2 precincts of towns by votes of their inhabitants may
3 establish zoning within their territorial limits, in
4 accordance with the provisions of sections twenty-
5 five to thirty, inclusive, of chapter forty of the General
6 Laws, as amended.
