### AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE IDENTIFICATION OF HACKNEY CARRIAGES IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The police commissioner of the city of Boston shall
- 2 not license or permit any hackney carriage or taxicab
- 3 to operate on the streets thereof unless the name or
- 4 owner of the said hackney carriage or taxicab shall
- 5 be painted in letters not less than three inches high
- 6 in a color easily distinguishable on the body on both
- 7 sides of said vehicle.
