Substituted by the House, on motion of Mr. Sylvia of Oak Bluffs, for a Bill authorizing the town of Edgartown to acquire and occupy property for the purpose of a municipally owned wharf (House, No. 1428). February 10.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Eight.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF EDGARTOWN TO ACQUIRE AND MAINTAIN PROPERTY THEREIN FOR THE PURPOSES OF A PUBLIC WHARF.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Edgartown may acquire
2 by purchase waterfront land and buildings thereon
3 in said town and may erect and maintain a public
4 wharf on said land. The powers conferred by this
5 act may be exercised by the selectmen, who shall also
6 have the power to make rules and regulations govern-
7 ing the use of said wharf.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of acquiring said land
2 and buildings and of erecting said wharf, said town
3 may borrow from time to time such sums as may be
4 necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, twelve
5 thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes there-
6 for, which shall bear on their face the words, Edgar-

7 town Wharf Loan, Act of 1938. Each authorized
8 issue shall constitute a separate loan and such loans
9 shall be paid in not more than ten years from their
10 dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be
11 within the statutory limit, but shall, except as pro-
12 vided herein, be subject to chapter forty-four of the
13 General Laws, exclusive of the limitation contained
14 in the first paragraph of section seven thereof.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
