The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO CO-OPERATE WITH THE MUNICIPAL FINANCE COMMISSION FOR THE TOWN OF MILLVILLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter four hundred and seventy of
2 the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-five is hereby
3 amended by inserting after section one the following
4 new section:—

5 *Section 1A.* The governor, with the advice and
6 consent of the council, shall appoint from the in-
7 habitants of the town three persons as an advisory
8 committee to co-operate with the commission. Said
9 advisory committee shall exercise advisory powers
10 only, and shall be furnished with suitable quarters
11 in the town hall building for holding its meetings and
12 for enabling it to properly exercise its powers. The
13 provisions relative to the term of office, removal and
14 filling of vacancies applicable to the commission shall

15 also apply to the said advisory committee. The
16 members of said advisory committee shall receive no
17 compensation for acting hereunder, but shall be paid
18 by the town their necessary traveling and other ex-
19 penses incurred in the exercise of their powers here-
20 under.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
