AN ACT TO REIMBURSE THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
FOR A CERTAIN PORTION OF THE PROCEEDS OF THE SALE
OF PRODUCTS OF THE STATE FORESTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subject to an appropriation by the general court,
2 there shall be paid out of the treasury of the com-
3 monwealth to the treasury of the United States of
4 America a sum not exceeding one half of the proceeds
5 of the sale of state forests products which have re-
6 sulted from the operations of the Civilian Conserva-
7 tion Corps to the extent and at the rate of one dollar
8 per man for the time spent on such work provided
9 such reimbursement shall not exceed the amount of
10 three dollars per acre. The commissioner of conserva-
11 tion shall fix and determine the amount of such pro-
12 ceeds which shall have accrued since April first, nine-
13 teen hundred and thirty-three, and shall annually
14 include in his annual forecast an item to cover such
15 reimbursement during the continuance of the emer-
16 gency conservation works.
