Mr. Valentine of Chelmsford presented a petition of Walter Perham and others (water commissioners) that the Chelmsford Water District be authorized to provide for an extension of its boundaries. Water Supply.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR EXTENSIONS OF THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CHELMSFORD WATER DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter six hundred and forty-one of
2 the acts of nineteen hundred and thirteen is hereby
3 amended by adding at the end thereof the following
4 section:—

5 *Section 15.* Upon a petition in writing addressed
6 to said commissioners requesting that certain real
7 estate, accurately described therein, located in said
8 town and abutting on said district and not otherwise
9 served by a public water supply be included within
10 the limits thereof, and signed by the owners of such
11 real estate, or a major portion thereof, said commis-
12 sioners shall cause a duly warned meeting of the dis-
13 trict to be called, at which meeting the voters may
14 vote on the question of including said real estate

15 within the district. If a majority of the voters pres-
16 ent and voting thereon vote in the affirmative the
17 district clerk shall within ten days file with the town
18 clerk of said town and with the state secretary an
19 attested copy of said petition and vote; and there-
20 upon said real estate shall become and be part of the
21 district and shall be holden under this act in the same
22 manner and to the same extent as the real estate
23 described in section one.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of meeting the ex-
2 pense of laying mains and pipes, said district may
3 borrow from time to time such sums as may be neces-
4 sary, not exceeding in the aggregate, fifteen thousand
5 dollars, and may issue bonds or notes therefor, which
6 shall bear on their face the words, Chelmsford Water
7 District Loan, Act of 1938. Each authorized issue
8 shall constitute a separate loan, and such loans shall
9 be payable in not more than fifteen years from their
10 dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be
11 subject to chapter forty-four of the General Laws
12 pertaining to such district.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
