AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE SOUTH END BRIDGE IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to reconstruct the South End
3 bridge over the Connecticut river in the city of
4 Springfield. For said purpose said department may
5 expend such sums not exceeding dollars
6 as may hereafter be appropriated therefor from the
7 Highway Fund.
