AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE NICHOLS JUNIOR COLLEGE TO
CONFER THE DEGREE OF ASSOCIATE IN BUSINESS ADMIN-
ISTRATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Nichols Junior College, a corporation incor-
2 porated under general law January twenty-fifth,
3 nineteen hundred and thirty-two, under the name of
4 Nichols, Inc., and whose name was changed to its
5 present one by chapter sixty-two of the acts of nine-
6 teen hundred and thirty-three, is hereby authorized
7 and empowered to grant to students properly ac-
8 credited and recommended by its faculty upon their
9 completion of the two year course in said junior col-
10 lege, the degree of associate in business administration.
