AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPROPRIATIONS FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The school committee of the city of
2 Cambridge shall annually appropriate money for the
3 maintenance of the schools and school buildings, and
4 for the salaries of all teachers and other employees,
5 including janitors of school buildings, employed by
6 them; provided, that the words "maintenance of
7 school buildings" shall not include the restoration of
8 a school building when damaged or destroyed by fire,
9 explosion, or other unavoidable casualty. Each such
10 appropriation shall be submitted by the school com-
11 mittee in budget form to the mayor for his approval
12 and shall be subject to the provisions of section fifty-
13 five of chapter forty-three of the General Laws in
14 like manner as orders or votes of the city council,
15 except that the affirmative vote of five of the mem-
16 bers of the school committee shall be necessary to
17 pass the appropriation over the veto of the mayor.

1 SECTION 2. So much of the provisions of section
2 thirty-one of chapter three hundred and sixty-four of
3 the acts of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, as

4 amended by section two of chapter five hundred and
5 sixty-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and seven,
6 by chapter three hundred and sixty-two of the acts
7 of nineteen hundred and eight, by chapter three hun-
8 dred and ninety-five of the acts of nineteen hundred
9 and nine and by section one of chapter eight hundred
10 and four of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirteen,
11 and so much of the provisions of chapter four hun-
12 dred and forty-one of the acts of nineteen hundred
13 and eleven, of chapter two hundred and forty-eight
14 of the Special Acts of nineteen hundred and nineteen,
15 of chapter one hundred and eighty-four of the acts of
16 nineteen hundred and twenty-six, and of chapter
17 three hundred and seventy-two of the acts of nine-
18 teen hundred and thirty, as regulates appropriations
19 for school purposes in said city and as is inconsistent
20 herewith is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
