RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES RELATIVE TO THE ADVISABILITY OF REGULATING THE SALE AND DISTRIBUTION BY PUBLIC UTILITY COMPANIES OF STEAM FOR HEATING OR MECHANICAL POWER.

1 *Resolved,* That the department of public utilities is
2 hereby authorized and directed to investigate the
3 advisability of providing for the regulation by the
4 commonwealth of the sale and distribution by public
5 utility companies of steam for heating or mechanical
6 power. Said department shall report to the general
7 court the results of its investigation, and its recom-
8 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation
9 necessary to carry said recommendations into effect,
10 by filing the same with the clerk of the house of repre-
11 sentatives on or before the first Wednesday of De-
12 cember in the current year.
