AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BLACKSTONE TO BORROW MONEY FOR HIGH SCHOOL, TOWN HALL AND FIRE ENGINE HOUSE PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of constructing an
2 addition to its high school and to its town hall and
3 originally furnishing and equipping said additions, of
4 making the necessary alterations to the existing high
5 school and town hall, and of making certain necessary
6 alterations to its fire engine house, so called, the town
7 of Blackstone may borrow from time to time, within
8 a period of five years from the passage of this act,
9 such sums of money as may be necessary, not exceed-
10 ing in the aggregate, sixty thousand dollars, and may
11 issue bonds or notes therefor, which shall bear on
12 their face the words, Blackstone High School, Town
13 Hall and Engine House Loan, Act of 1938. Each

14 authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and
15 such loans shall be paid in not more than twenty
16 years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under
17 this act shall be within the statutory limit, but shall,
18 except as provided herein, be subject to chapter forty-
19 four of the General Laws, exclusive of the limitation
20 contained in the first paragraph of section seven
21 thereof.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
