AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS FOR REGISTRATION AS QUALIFIED PHYSICIANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section three of chapter two hundred
2 and forty-seven of the acts of nineteen hundred and
3 thirty-six is hereby amended by striking out, in the
4 third line, the word "thirty-nine" and inserting in
5 place thereof the word: — forty-one, — so as to read
6 as follows: — *Section 3.* The provisions of said sec-
7 tion two of said chapter one hundred and twelve as
8 existing immediately prior to January first, nineteen
9 hundred and forty-one shall continue to govern as to
10 the eligibility of any applicant for registration as a
11 qualified physician who shall have matriculated prior
12 to said date in any legally chartered medical school
13 having power to confer degrees in medicine, but
14 subject, however, to the provisions of section two of
15 chapter one hundred and seventy-one of the acts of
16 nineteen hundred and thirty-three.

1 SECTION 2. Section six of said chapter two hundred
2 and forty-seven is hereby amended by striking out,
3 in the fourth line, the word "thirty-nine" and insert-

4 ing in place thereof the word: — forty-one, — so as to.
5 read as follows: — *Section 6.* The provisions of this
6 act providing new eligibility requirements for appli-
7 cants for registration as qualified physicians shall
8 become effective January first, nineteen hundred and
9 forty-one.
