## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Eight.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LISTING OF VOTERS IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section eight of chapter two hundred and eighty-  
2 two of the General Acts of nineteen hundred and  
3 eighteen, as most recently amended by section eight  
4 of chapter two hundred and thirty-nine of the acts  
5 of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, is hereby  
6 amended by striking out at the end thereof the words  
7 “ex officiis”, — so as to read as follows: — *Section 8.*  
8 There is hereby established in the city of Cambridge  
9 a listing board composed of the chief of police of the  
10 city and the board of election commissioners.
