RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE ARMORY COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ACQUISITION OF LAND IN THE CITY OF LOWELL FOR ARMORY PURPOSES THEREIN.

1 *Resolved*, That the armory commission is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to investigate the subject  
3 matter of current house document numbered six  
4 hundred and sixty, relative to the acquisition of land  
5 in the city of Lowell for armory purposes, with a view  
6 to determining the advisability and probable cost of  
7 acquiring the parcel of land referred to in said house  
8 document. Said commission shall report to the general  
9 court the results of its investigation hereunder, and  
10 its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of  
11 legislation necessary to carry said recommendations  
12 into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the  
13 house of representatives on or before the first Wednes-  
14 day of December in the current year.
