Substituted by the House, on motion of Mr. Whiton of Quincy, for a report of the committee on Public Health, reference to the next annual session (under Joint Rule 10), on the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 201) of Joseph L. Whiton that relief be provided in the city of Quincy and the town of Weymouth against escape of cinders and other solids from buildings in which furnaces with forced draft are used. May 5.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES RELATIVE TO PROVIDING RELIEF IN THE CITY OF QUINCY AND TOWN OF WEYMOUTH AGAINST THE ESCAPE OR DISCHARGE OF CINDERS, ASHES OR OTHER SOLIDS FROM BUILDINGS IN OR UPON WHICH A FURNACE OR BOILER WITH A FORCED OR INDUCED DRAFT IS USED.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public utilities
2 is hereby authorized and directed to investigate the
3 subject matter of current house document numbered
4 two hundred and one, relative to providing relief in
5 the city of Quincy and town of Weymouth against
6 the escape or discharge of cinders, ashes or other
7 solids from buildings in or upon which a furnace or
8 boiler with a forced or induced draft is used. Said
9 department shall report to the general court the re-
10 sults of its investigations and its recommendations,

11 if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary
12 to carry said recommendations into effect, by filing
13 the same with the clerk of the house of representa-
14 tives on or before the first Wednesday of December
15 in the current year.
