## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Eight.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE PRINTING AND SALE OF THE COMPLETE REPORT OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ON TAXATION AND PUBLIC EXPENDITURES.

1   *Resolved*, That the clerk of the house of representa-  
2 tives is hereby authorized and directed to cause to be  
3 printed in a single volume Parts I to XVI of the  
4 Report of the Special Commission on Taxation and  
5 Public Expenditures, established by chapter three of  
6 the resolves of nineteen hundred and thirty-seven.  
7 Twenty-five hundred copies of said volume shall be  
8 printed as aforesaid and the state secretary shall  
9 place said copies on sale at such price per copy, not  
10 less than the cost of printing and binding, as shall be  
11 fixed by him. For the purposes of this resolve, there  
12 may be expended a sum not exceeding twenty-five  
13 hundred dollars, which shall be paid from the unex-  
14 pended balance of the amount appropriated by item  
15 thirty-six a of section two of chapter four hundred and  
16 thirty-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and  
17 thirty-seven.
