RESOLVE AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION OF THE CONTROL OF A PORTION OF THE STATE MUSTER FIELD, SO CALLED, AT FRAMINGHAM.

1 *Resolved*, That the adjutant general is hereby  
2 authorized, with the approval of the governor and  
3 council, and subject to such terms and conditions as  
4 the adjutant general may prescribe with like ap-  
5 proval, to transfer to the department of conservation  
6 the control of a portion of the land owned by the  
7 commonwealth in the town of Framingham, known  
8 as the state muster field, consisting of six and fifty-  
9 nine hundredths acres, southerly of and abutting on  
10 the Worcester Turnpike, so called, and easterly of  
11 and abutting on other land of the commonwealth  
12 under the control of the department of public safety;  
13 provided, that the transfer of control hereby author-  
14 ized shall not be made until there shall have been  
15 filed in the office of the state secretary a plan show-  
16 ing said portion of said land and the metes and  
17 bounds thereof.
