AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MEDFORD TO USE
CERTAIN PARK LAND FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Medford is hereby author-
2 ized to use for school and school-yard purposes such
3 portion of a certain parcel of land situated on Main
4 street and Morton avenue in said city, known as
5 Tufts park, and now used by said city for park pur-
6 poses, as may be designated by the board of alder-
7 men of said city, with the approval of the mayor;
8 and thereafter the portion aforesaid shall be under
9 the same care and control as other school property.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
