AN ACT PROVIDING A MANDATORY SENTENCE FOR PERSONS
GUILTY OF THE CRIME OF ASSAULT AND BATTERY BY
KICKING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 14 of chapter 265 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby
3 amended by adding at the end thereof the following
4 sentence:— Notwithstanding the foregoing provi-
5 sions, whoever, by kicking another person, commits
6 the crime of assault and battery as herein provided
7 shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than
8 one year.
