To accompany the petition of Andrew P. Quigley, Harry Coltun and another that provision be made for the removal of the existing dormitory building and the construction of a new building at the Soldiers' Home in Massachusetts. Military Affairs and Public Safety.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR REMOVAL OF EXISTING DORMITORY BUILDING AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADDITIONAL BUILDING AT THE SOLDIERS' HOME IN MASSACHUSETTS, CHELSEA.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The trustees of the Soldiers' Home, Chelsea, are  
2 hereby authorized to remove the present out-dated  
3 building known as Sargent Hall, and in its place con-  
4 struct an additional building and purchase equipment  
5 which will serve as a modern fireproof structure for  
6 the care of three hundred domiciliary cases, and after  
7 an appropriation has been made therefor, may ex-  
8 pend the following amounts for the purposes desig-  
9 nated: —

1. Removal of existing building . . . . .	\$150,000 00
2. New dormitory building . . . . .	1,750,000 00
