To accompany the petition of James P. Meehan, mayor of Lawrence, for legislation to increase the amount that said city may appropriate for the purposes of the development and industrial committee. Municipal Finance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY THE CITY OF LAWRENCE MAY APPROPRIATE FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE DEVELOPMENT AND INDUSTRIAL COMMITTEE OF SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 661 of the acts
2 of 1950 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 4,
3 the word "three" and inserting in place thereof the
4 the word:— five, — and by striking out, in line 5,
5 the word "fifteen" and inserting in place thereof the
6 word:— twenty-five, — so that the first sentence will
7 read as follows:— Notwithstanding the provisions of
8 any general or special law to the contrary, the city of
9 Lawrence may appropriate from available funds or
10 otherwise, annually, for five years commencing in the
11 current year, a sum not to exceed twenty-five thousand
12 dollars in any one year, for the purpose of creating

13 in the department of finance and public affairs in said
14 city a committee for industrial development for the
15 promotion and development of the industrial resources
16 of said city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
