### AN ACT PROVIDING A MINIMUM RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. All retired employees of the common-  
2 wealth shall receive a minimum retirement allowance  
3 of not less than eighty dollars per month.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to all persons who  
2 were retired prior to the effective date of this act.
