

To accompany the petition of Andrew B. Holmstrom, mayor of Worcester, that the Commissioner of Mental Health be directed to release restrictions on a certain parcel of land in said city. Public Welfare.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE COMMISSIONER OF MENTAL HEALTH TO RELEASE RESTRICTIONS ON A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN THE CITY OF WORCESTER.

1 *Whereas*, The Commissioner of Mental Health was
2 directed by chapter 335 of the acts of 1946 to sell and
3 convey, in the name and on behalf of the Common-
4 wealth a certain parcel of land located in the city of
5 Worcester to said city for recreational and safety pur-
6 poses only; and

7 *Whereas*, The Commissioner of Mental Health ex-
8 ecuted and delivered a deed of said land pursuant to
9 the authority of that act, said deed being dated Au-
10 gust nineteenth, nineteen hundred and forty-six; and

11 *Whereas*, It is now desired to release restrictions
12 from a certain portion of the land so sold which limit
13 the use thereof to recreational and safety purposes,
14 in order that it may be sold free of such encumbrances;
15 therefore

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commissioner of mental health is
2 hereby authorized and directed, in the name and on

3 behalf of the commonwealth, to abandon and release
4 to the city of Worcester for the sum of one dollar any
5 and all right, title and interest the commonwealth may
6 have, either in its own right or as owner of certain
7 neighboring lands, in or to a certain parcel of land lo-
8 cated in said city at the northeast corner of Lake
9 avenue and Belmont street and containing about ten
10 thousand square feet, more or less.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
