AN ACT PROVIDING FOR HIGHWAY WORK BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION IN MYLES STANDISH FOREST AND OTHER RECREATIONAL AREAS IN THE COUNTY OF PLYMOUTH AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of conservation is
2 hereby authorized and directed to maintain, construct,
3 reconstruct and repair ways and bridges thereon in
4 the Myles Standish State Forest, more particularly
5 described as follows: — (1) About three and six tenths
6 miles of roads extending from the existing surfaced
7 road known as East Head road from the Plymouth-
8 Carver line to a line southeasterly to the Southeast
9 line road, and then easterly to East line road, and
10 then easterly on Southeast line road to East line road,
11 and thence northerly by East line road to Cutter's
12 line road and beginning of new road to Camp Barker;
13 (2) about two and two tenths miles of road extending
14 from the Long Pond road to the picnic area at College
15 pond; and (3) approaches and roads to the camping area
16 at Fearing, Charge and College ponds and elsewhere,
17 as may seem necessary to the said department. All such
18 ways and bridges, located in the county of Plymouth,
19 shall be considered public highways.

1 SECTION 2. For the work authorized in section one
2 of this act not exceeding the sum of
3 dollars is hereby appropriated from the Highway Fund.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
