RESOLVE EXTENDING THE TIME IN WHICH THE COMMISSIONERS TO REVISE, RECODIFY, CONSOLIDATE AND ARRANGE THE GENERAL LAWS ARE AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO REPORT SUBSTANTIVE CHANGES IN THE GENERAL LAWS AND TO MAKE THEIR FINAL REPORT.

1 *Resolved*, That the commissioners for revising, re-
2 codifying, consolidating and arranging the General
3 Laws appointed under chapter ninety-four of the
4 resolves of nineteen hundred and forty-eight are
5 authorized and directed to execute the revision, re-
6 codification, consolidation and arrangements of the
7 General Laws provided for in said chapter ninety-
8 four in accordance with the provisions thereof, and
9 the provisions of chapter thirty-three of the resolves
10 of nineteen hundred and fifty-one shall not apply.
11 Said commissioners shall report in print their recom-
12 mendations for substantive changes to the General
13 Court on the first Monday of January, nineteen
14 hundred and fifty-three, and shall submit their report
15 of said revision on the first day of May, nineteen
16 hundred and fifty-three. Said commissioners are
17 hereby directed to make monthly reports of progress
18 to the committee on the Judiciary until the sub-
19 mission of their final report to the General Court and
20 said committee is hereby authorized to sit during the
21 sessions of the General Court and during the recess
22 thereof for the purpose of receiving such reports.

24 hereby amended by striking out all after the word
25 "monthly," in line 16.
